

Parental Inspection of and Objection to Instructional Materials

A. Parental Right to Inspect Materials

Parents may review all instructional materials. Instructional materials do not include academic tests or assessments. Parents who would like to inspect and review instructional materials should make a request in writing to the principal. The principal or designee shall schedule a mutually agreeable date and time for the parent to come into the school to review the materials. All efforts should be made to schedule the time as soon as possible but no later than 10 business days from the date of the request.

B. Parental Objection to Materials

Parents may submit an objection in writing to the principal regarding the use of particular instructional materials. The principal or designee shall establish a committee to review the objection.

If the committee determines that any material violates constitutional or other legal rights of the parent or student, the committee shall either remove the material from instructional use or accommodate the particular student and parent.

The decision of the committee may be appealed to the principal. The decision of the principal may be appealed to the board. The decision of the board is final.
